I find it beautifully intriguing that, despite our collective awareness that the practice of the faith has vastly decreased, most people still cling to the "spirit of the season" as something to be marked and celebrated. Whether it's the countless Hallmark Christmas movies, the "winter" lights lining the streets, companies throwing parties for their employees and their families, or nearly everyone, for one night, staying put with the people they care most about, there remains an innate awareness that *there is something different here*. Easter may be forgotten but Christmas is still here. This makes me think of the shepherds or magi as they came to Bethlehem and if they were able to recognize much more than the fact that *there's something different here*. Even with Mary we do not know how much she knew or was aware of the reality of who her Son was. The passage I always get hung up on is "Mary kept all these things, pondering them in her heart" (Luke 2:19); deeply thinking that *there's something different here* at the edge of the manger. I pray that through all the hustle and bustle of preparations and celebrations, you might find time to ponder that at this time of the year, even if only for a moment, for more people than are willing to admit, *there is something different here*.


